I shall be very happy to serve as one of a committee for the establishment of what I understand to be a marine or nautical museum for the entire county.

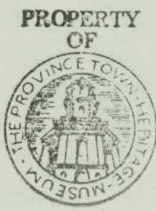
Provincetown being the most historical town on the cape, and having the best harbor on the cape, and one to which all yachts lay their course, is naturally the site for such an enterprise.
