## CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

Article II. Objects and Purposes. Also to hold exhibitions of paintings and other works of art and to promote the advancement of art by means of social intercourse between artists and those interested in the arts.

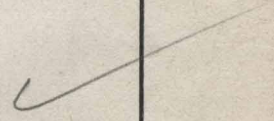
