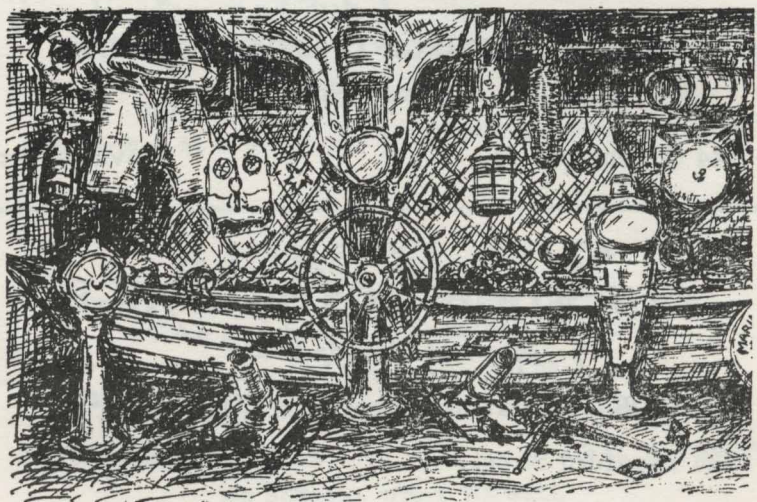

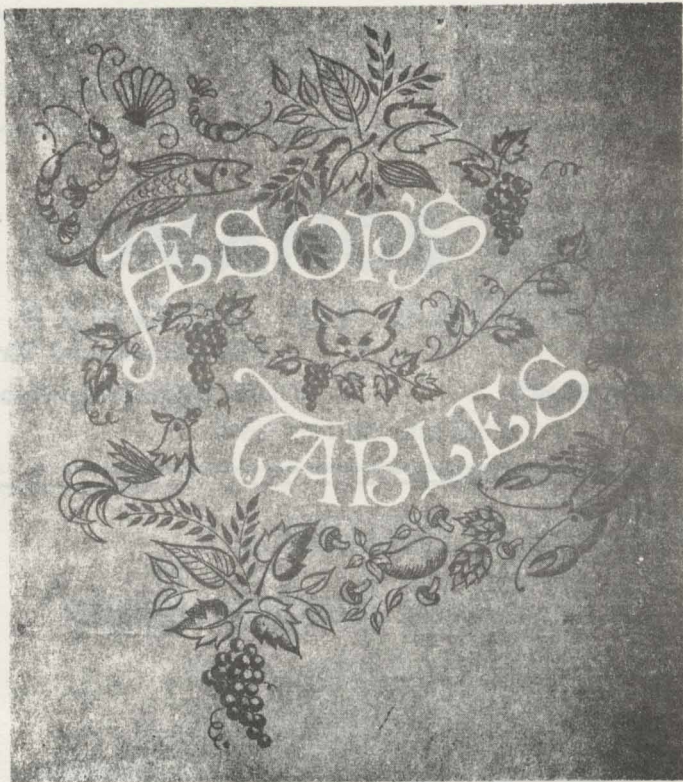

The Provincetown Art Association will abandon its usual program this summer to take an experimental tack. The first two exhibitions will be completely open, non-juried shows. This is an attempt on our part to encourage participation in the Association by all Cape artists, young and old, of whatever esthetic position. Every Art Association member can show his work in the first two shows in a kind of Provincetown "Salon de Mai".

The third show will be an invitational exhibition, selected by the honorary vice-presidents by ballot, and greatly reduced in the number of works shown. It is an attempt to use the dramatic space of our building properly to display fewer works of more impressive scale and importance than has been possible under past policies. A number of those invited for the third show will be selected on the basis of work displayed in the first two open shows. (Some regular exhibitors who will not show in this year's third exhibition we hope to rotate to show in next summer's invitational.)

These changes are designed to encourage the participation of all Cape artists, young and old, who have not joined us in the past due to reservations about juried shows, or the restrictive size limitations we have been forced to adopt in the past. We hope to demonstrate by these innovations in our policies the variety and strength and impressive scale of the Provincetown Art Community.

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

Article II. Objects and Purposes. The objects and purposes of this Association shall be to promote and cultivate the practice and appreciation of all branches of the fine arts, to assemble and maintain for the town of Provincetown, a collection of works of art of merit, to hold temporary exhibitions, and by forums, concerts, and similar activities to promote education of the public in the arts, and social intercourse between artists and laymen. To these ends it shall operate strictly within its charter as a non-profit, educational, artistic, and cultural organization.

MEMBERS

Section 1. Membership in this association shall be divided as follows:

- a. Artist Member—Dues \$7.50 per year.
- b. Contributing Member—Dues \$10.00 per year.
- c. Friend Member—Dues \$25.00 per year.
- d. Life Member—A single due of \$100.00.
- e. Patron—A single due of \$200.00 or more.
- f. Benefactor—A single due of \$500.00 or more.

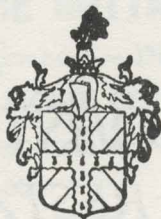
