I am the concert manager who recently played JOSEF HOFMANN in Denver to an audience of approximately seventy five hundred people. I notice that a picture of this engagement appeared in the last issue of your monthly bulletin.

My purpose in writing you now is to call to your attention MISS THELMA GIVEN, violinist, who is now filling a number of engagements in my territory. Miss Given opened her tour at Boulder, Colorado, February 28th in the big Auditorium of the State University and scored a tremendous success. The local manager called me long distance the next morning and fairly raved. He said she was called back for encore after encore and after the last number almost the entire audience crowded on the stage to express their appreciation of her marvellous work. They have had some big artists in Boulder this season, - as for example EDWARD JOHNSON just the month before but he was accorded no such enthusiastic appreciation as was Miss Given. Everywhere else it has been the same and she has appeared in most of the largest cities in this territory. She has called forth a veritable storm of praise and not one single adverse criticism has been voiced, which is most unusual, for some of the smaller places are the most critical when it comes to music.

In my opinion Miss Given is without equal among the woman violinists and ranks high among the finest of the men. Knowing that you have no such artist on your list I wondered if I could not interest you in her. Her home is in New York and she will be back there in a few weeks. May I not tell her to come in and see you for a try-out? I might mention here that she has played with the Philadelphia Symphony several times and is engaged to appear with them again this spring?

I would very much appreciate a reply from you at your early convenience. I believe firmly that an affiliation would be to the mutual advantage of your Company and the artist.
