

FISH TRAP LICENSE
ISSUED BY THE
TOWN OF PROVINCETOWN, MASS.

Annual Fee, \$ 25.00 and in addition thereto 1 per cent. of the Gross Receipts

The Selectmen of the Town of Provincetown, under authority of Chapter 130 of the General Laws, Section 145, as amended by Chapter 24 of the Acts of 1921, hereby authorize

John P. Silva of Provincetown, Mass.

to construct and operate a fish weir or trap within the limits of the Town of Provincetown, for a term of 2 years from the date of this license.

The total length of said fish weir or trap in Herring Cove, Provincetown hereby licensed shall not exceed 2000 feet, and the inshore end shall be not less than 300 feet and not more than 2000 feet from the mean high water line.

The location of said fish weir or trap is designated No. 4-A on a map of Provincetown Harbor, scale 1 : 10,000, dated July, 1918, on file in the office of the Selectmen of Provincetown and in the office of the Department of Public Works, Division of Waterways and Public Lands, and shall be in a line whose course or bearing is South 67 West (magnetic), from a bound or stake in a base line whose course or bearing is South 15 East (magnetic). From said bound or stake Race Point Light bears North 32 West (magnetic) and the Pilgrim Monument bears North 75 East (magnetic), as shown on said map.

This license is granted subject to the approval of the Division of Waterways and Public Lands of the Department of Public Works, and to the following Regulations; and any neglect or failure on the part of the licensee to comply with said Regulations shall be sufficient cause for revocation or cancellation of his license by the Selectmen.

1. "The licensee shall annually on or before December 14 of each year, submit to the Selectmen a statement of the gross receipts of the current year. If the Selectmen shall deem it necessary to require an examination of the books and accounts of the licensee at any time for the purpose of verifying statements that may be made, ample opportunity for such examination shall be afforded by the licensee."
2. The annual license fee must be paid on or before March 1 of each year, and the percentage of gross receipts paid on or before December 15 of each year.
3. The Selectmen reserve the right to revoke and cancel this license at any time, if the licensee, after written notice from the Selectmen and within a reasonable period to be designated in said notice, refuses or neglects to construct, operate or use the weir or trap duly licensed and approved.
4. This license shall not be transferred or assigned without the written assent of the Selectmen.
5. The Selectmen reserve the right to make from time to time such further regulations, with respect to fish weirs and traps and the licensing thereof, as they may deem necessary and advisable.
