In accordance with the law, authorization is hereby granted, with necessary approvals as appearing below, to Silva Trap of Provincetown, Mass. to construct and maintain a Fish Weir in the tidal waters of the city or town of Provincetown Harbor Provincetown at the location described below.

This authorization expires Two years from date unless sooner revoked and is not transferable.

I hereby make application for authority to construct and maintain a WEIR, POUND NET OR FISH TRAP in the tidal waters within the limits of the above-mentioned city or town.

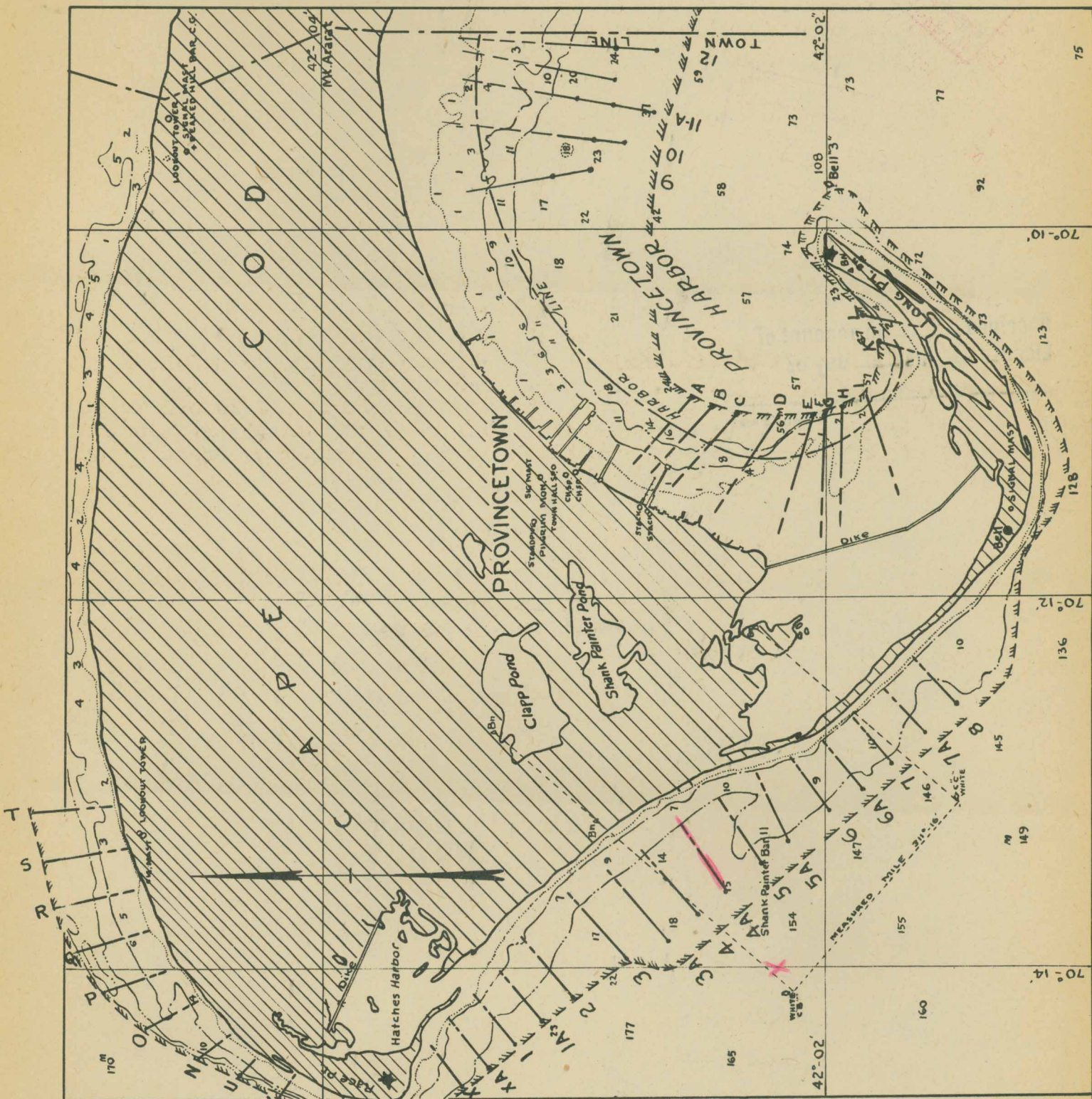
