One Fish *Trap* in the tide waters of this town within the following bounds and limits, namely: Commencing *One half way between J. J. Lewis Main* ~~at a stake~~ feet from ~~and the Trap of Lebarde A Cook.~~

~~to a point which shall not exceed~~ *Six* fathoms depth at ordinary high water. Provided that said *Trap* causes no obstruction to navigation and does not encroach upon the rights of other persons. This license cannot be sold, assigned, or leased, without the written consent of the Selectmen. Subject to revocation by said Board of Selectmen for cause, after a hearing being given to parties interested.
