Dear Senator Stone,

I want to thank you for your recent letter and your continued interest in the proposed development of Provincetown.

Last evening I spoke to Mrs. Tarvers in Provincetown and she told me that she had seen you this past week in Boston. At that time you informed her, I believe, that Bill # 3290 which ~~that~~ was before the Senate, had been dropped, and that you were substituting a new bill that would give approximately 600 acres of the Province Lands to Provincetown with specific recommendations as to its use.

Is it possible for you to send me a copy of this new bill and a map showing the area under consideration? I ask this not only in my name, but in the name of a large group of Provincetown taxpayers residing in the New York area, who are genuinely concerned with the future development of our town.
