Text of Letter to Udall:

I should like to bring to your attention the enclosed two letters, copies of which have been sent to Senators Smith and Bible as well as to Senator Saltonstall. You will see for yourself that the matter to which these letters refer involves a very important aspect of the Cape Ced National Seashore Park. Our committee has been working for some months to preserve the Province Lands in their entirety here in Provincetown and this position has considerable support among the voters. We hope that the Cengress and other officials who are responsible for instituting the Park bill will not be hasty in turning over this land to the town since it seems clear at this writing that only a small minority wish its acquisition. We were very encouraged to learn that the Assistant Secretary of the Interior supports our view and we hope that you yourself will give this matter your utmost consideration.
