**Viking Wall Preserved**

PROVINCETOWN, May 15 — A wall which was supposed to have been built in 1,003 by Vikings has been well preserved in the Provincetown Museum. The remains of the wall were discovered in 1853 when a house was being built. It bears out the contention of historians that Leif, the son of Eric the Red, came to Cape Cod from Labrador and Nova Scotia in 1003.
