The building next east of the New Central House has been taken apart and removed in sections to land of Mr. Henry Pierce, where it is to be re-assembled. This building, which together with the land adjacent, was purchased by the New Central House proprietor recently, was previously owned by the late Mary Elizabeth Crowell and had occupied its late site fully 45 years, it is said. Its removal makes for a widened view from the hotel and furnishes needed increase of hotel grounds.
