Trucks Try Their Water Wings on Jetty Project



Arguments between the "boss" of the job and sub-contractors who truck the boulders, as well as mishaps to men and machinery, have retarded construction of Provincetown's 11 new east end jetties. Getting the stones in place on the beach, the men work against time and tide, and only a few hours each day are available for the work. Some truck owners balk at the prospect of using their land vehicles as amphibians even though the giant bulldozer stands by to pull them out if they get in too deep, as pictured above. The jetty in the process of construction here is situated in the rear of the Fishermen's Cold Storage.
