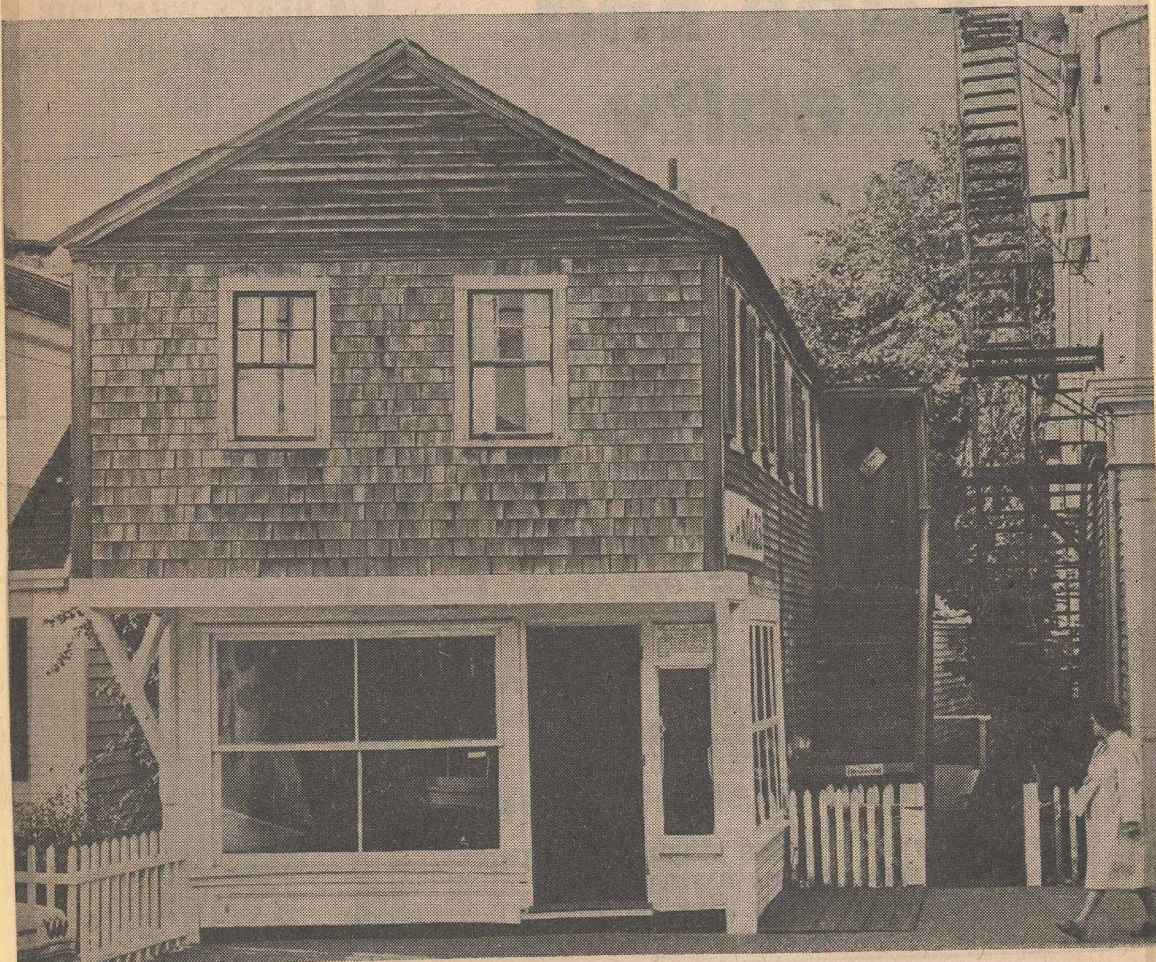


# IN MEMORIAM
