Services were held Tuesday afternoon at the Nickerson Funeral Home with the Rev. Edgar A. Reed of the Provincetown Methodist Church officiating for Mrs. Edna E. Rodgers Rich, 81, of Soper Street who died Saturday in Taunton. Interment was in Provincetown Cemetery.
