

RAISED AGAIN — The submarine S-4 was afloat again in 1928 after refitting and repair at Boston Naval Shipyard, following the disaster of Dec. 17, 1927 when the 231-foot submarine sank near Wood End off the tip of

Provincetown. Forty men lost their lives when the submarine was struck by the Coast Guard destroyer Spaulding. An annual memorial service last December at St. Mary of the Harbor Church honored the dead.
