The use that the two parking areas near the center of town are getting these days is clearly demonstrated in this air view taken from the Stinson Sightseer operated from Provincetown Airport. Near the water is the most recently constructed area between the two piers. The Grace Hall parking lot is in the background (to the right of the Christopher Wren Tower of the Universalist Church) with St. Peter's Parish Hall in the lower right hand corner. In the parking area between the two wharfs there is little car parking room to spare. It is difficult to imagine the problems that would exist in Provincetown these days if the voters had not in recent years had the foresight necessary to provide these two car parking areas.
