In this beautiful 1958 postcard from the top of the Monument, the absence of the many wharves Provincetown used to have, is very conspicuous (compare with older views in this book). Lower left is the Center School as it looks today. Center Methodist Church (now the Chrysler Art Museum) upper left. The long wharf is Town Wharf (or Railroad Wharf as it used to be called when the Railroad ran its tracks down to the end of it). Next wharf on left is Higgins Wharf; in upper left can be seen the runway of the Eastern Cold Storage and on lower right almost out of the picture is Sklaroff's (or "Green") Wharf. The sandy beach between Sklaroff's and Town Wharf is now a town parking lot.

Note shadow of the Monument at lower left.

Highland Light can be seen on the horizon, right of center.
