The dilemma of a town whose fishing industry now cannot support the population in winter — and faces risk to its vacation trade by inviting other industries has been the subject of repeated debate by local groups trying to resolve the problem. The loss of the large unloading shed presents another problem to the local fishing industry, which once put Provincetown next to Gloucester in the size and importance of its haul.

Monument Dock is better known to many veteran vacationers as Sklaroff's Wharf, its name for more than 35 years until the Monument Fish Co. Inc., Inc., took over the pier and facilities seven years ago.
