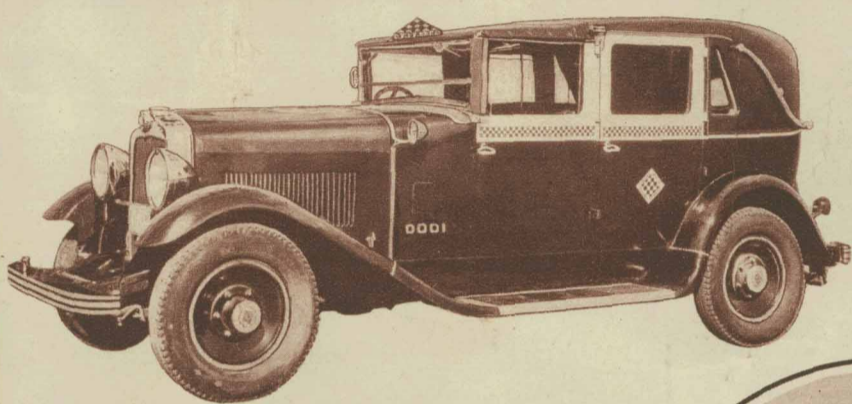

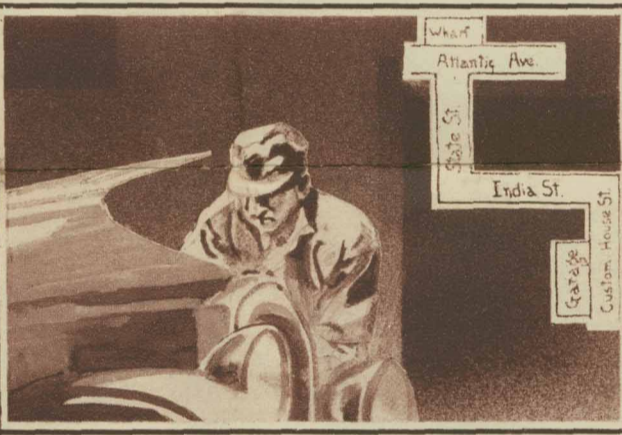

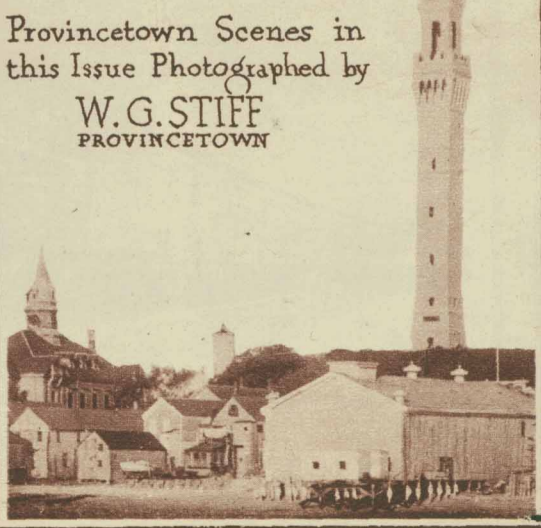
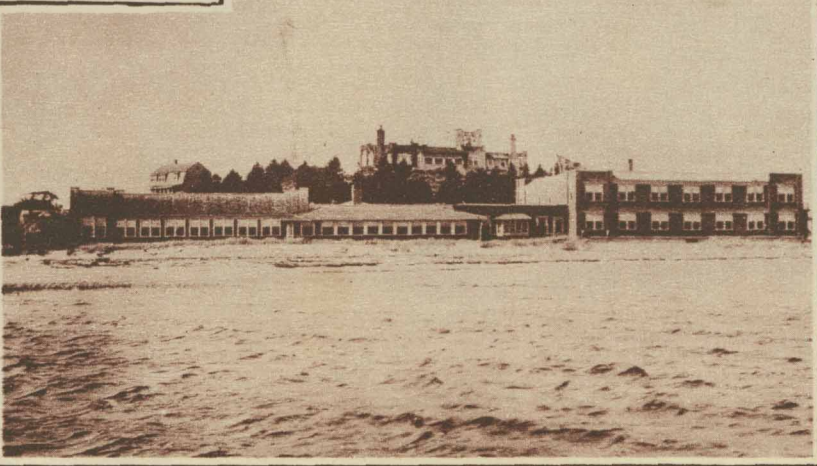


Below—THE PROVINCETOWN INN
