## Did You Know:

That the only wood on Wood End, Provincetown, is in the structures of the Coast Guard and lighthouse buildings there? Not a single tree or shrub stands today on the sandspit, originally named for timber growth with which it once abounded.

"Doubtless in 1620 the land was well wooded. The name "Wood End," still applied to a portion of Long Point, preserves the tradition that the forest once extended to the very bring of the sea." From Deyo's "History of Barnstable County.
