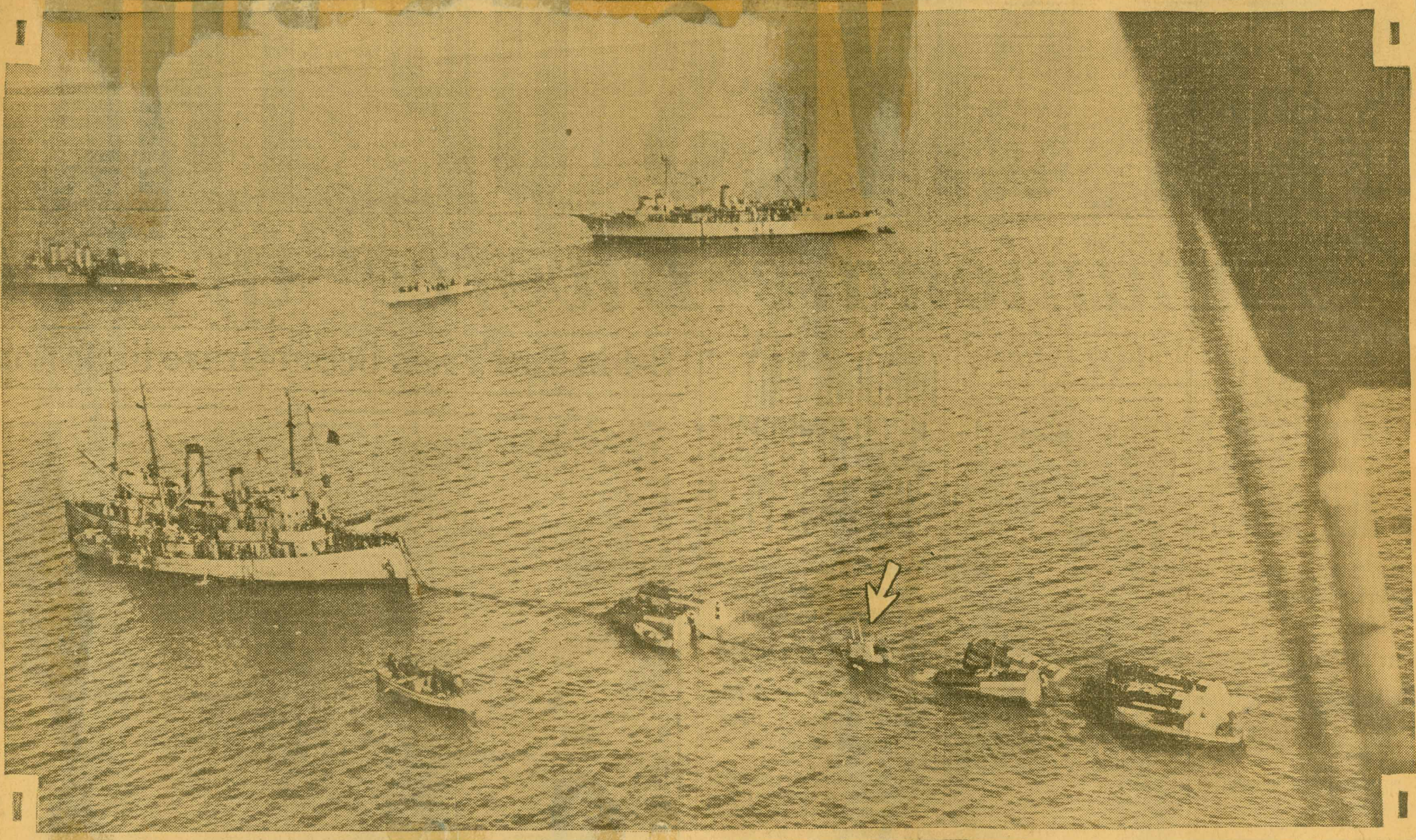


Resurrection from the Sea—Return of the Lost Submarine S-4

UP FROM AN OCEAN TOMB, yesterday, came eight of the hero dead of the sunken submarine S-4, which was raised after three months under sea. Arrow points to conning tower of the submarine, supported by six pontoons. Two naval tugs, close together, are shown on the left. At rear left is the U. S. destroyer J. K. Paulding, in center the U. S. S. Falcon, all naval craft assisting in retrieving the undersea boat sunk on December 17.
