
## WHARF WORK 1900:

WHARF WORK 1900: Captain John Atkins has hauled his large sailboat into carpenter Bickers work yard for a general overhauling . . . Cap-tain Whitcomb and his gang of workmen are at work on Knowles Wharf putting in new deck stringers, etc. A large por-tion of the wharf has been repaired but the decking at the lower end for a dis-tance of nearly 100 feet will all be re-moved and the wharf made as good as new. The whole time used in repairs to the wharf will probably exceed four or five weeks. five weeks.
