18 Standish Street is a 2-story, 3-bay sidehall cottage. Front-gable roof; brick chimney at ridge; shed wall dormer on south slope, 2 small shed roof wall dormers on north slope. Partial cornice returns and frieze below eaves. Entry contains pane-and-panel door with storm; wood deck; simple wood surround. Windows include 2/2, 2/1 and 1/1 DHS, some replacement. Secondary entry with wood stoop on rear of south facade. 1-1/2-story addition (c.2003) extends east of main block. Separate entrance here on east facade.
