October 30, 1990

A Provincetown man and 13 fire fighters were hurt and 12 left homeless as fire destroyed the Pilgrim House. The fire tore through several downtown buildings between Bradford and Commercial Streets. According to Fire Chief James F. Meads, the fire appeared to be very suspicious.
