Dear Mr. Silva;

Enclosed is the entire list of paintings, artifacts and furniture, equipment, etc. that has properly itemized and appraised to date in the Heritage Museum. This list also includes as much of the paintings owned by the town in the various locations indicated. In the spring, the Art Commission in conjunction with ourselves hopes to finish the job of appraising everything owned by the town in the same way.

The list of library furiture and equipment was appraised by Eldred Appraisers. The list of paintings in the school was appraised by the Shore Galleries in 1970. The appraisal on all other items was done by the museum, as we are allowed under Federal Law to place an appraisal not exceeding \$200.00 on any item given to us.

I hope this will protect the valuable art works temporarily. I intend to see that the list is brought up to fate continually, but I did not want to see another winter to by without this protection.

As you known, the heat and smoke detection system is currently being installed. I would hope that it may make a difference in the insurance rate. There are now a total of 7 ABC 10 lb. fire extinguishers in the building placed on every floor in full view including the basement as per the request of May 24, 1976 in the survey of Joseph Schadhauser.
