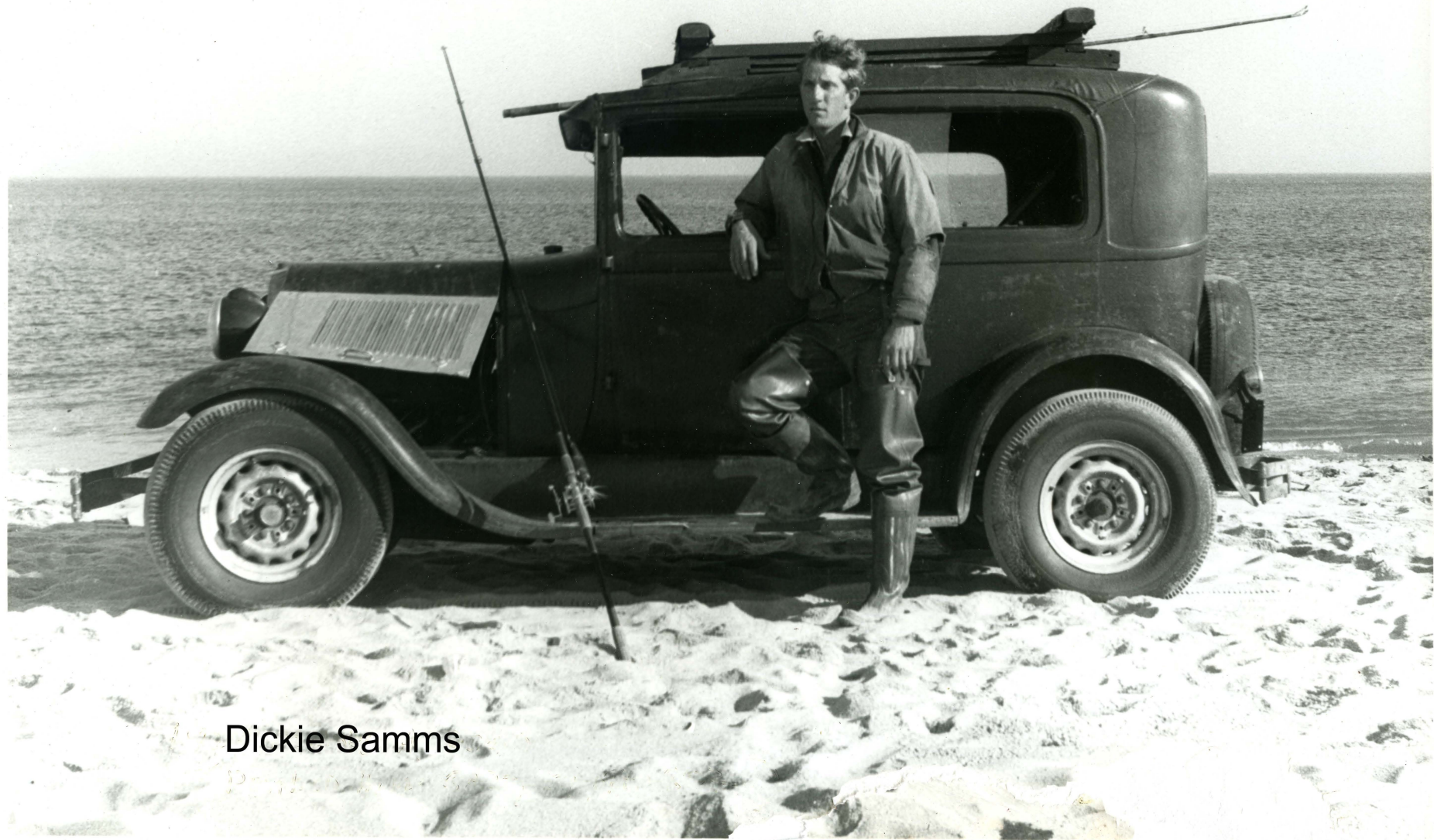

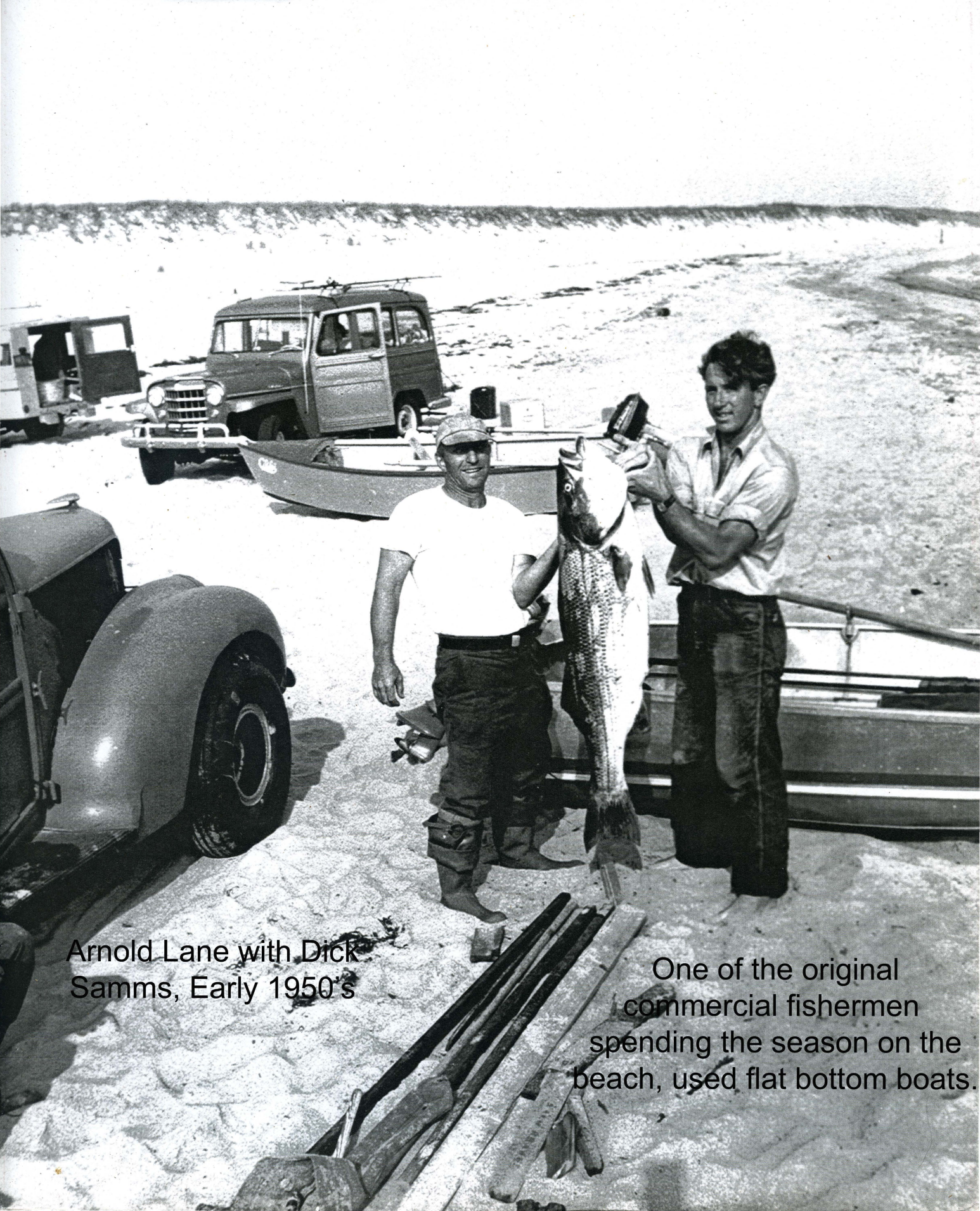

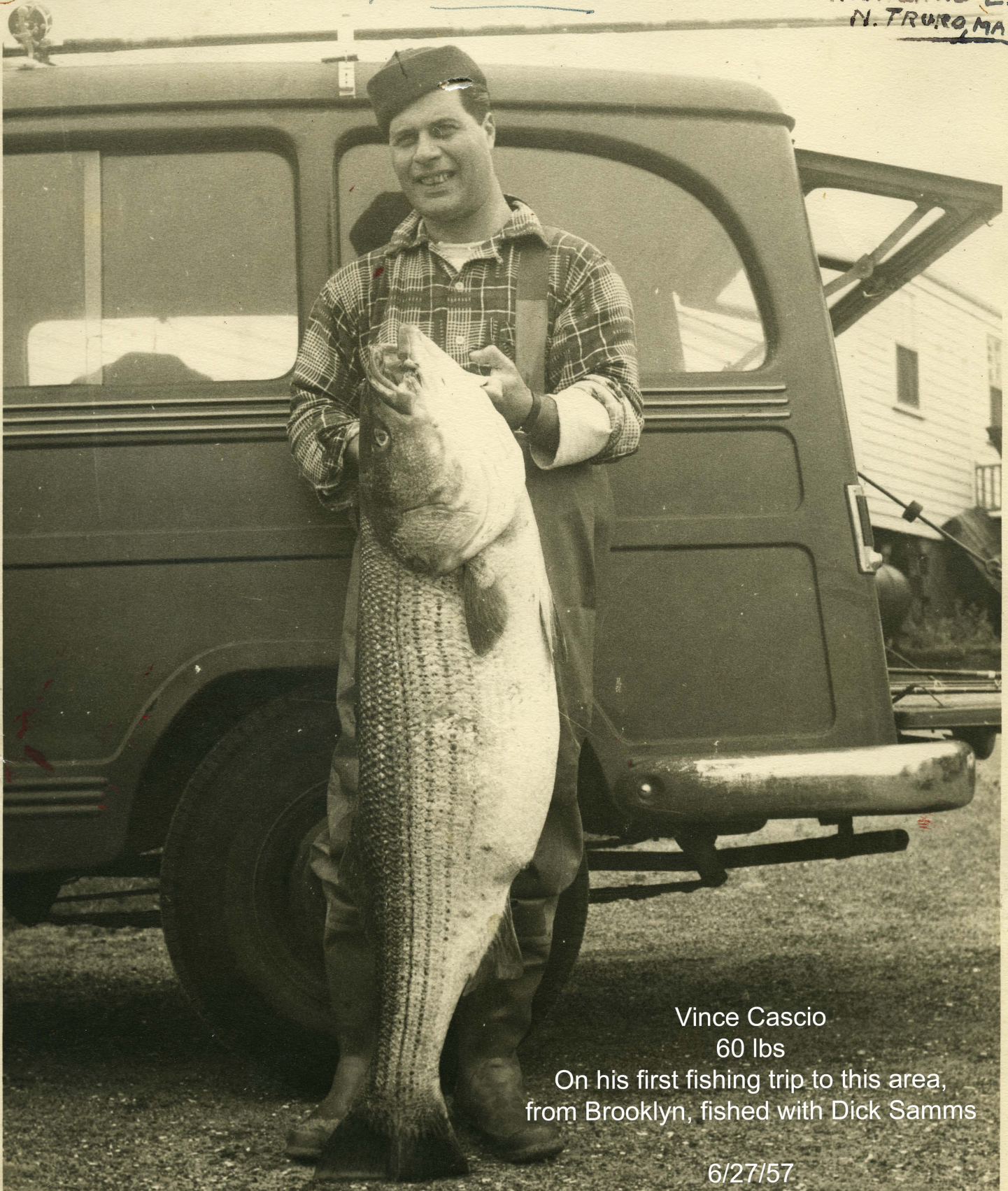
Arnold Lane with Dick Samms, Early 1950's

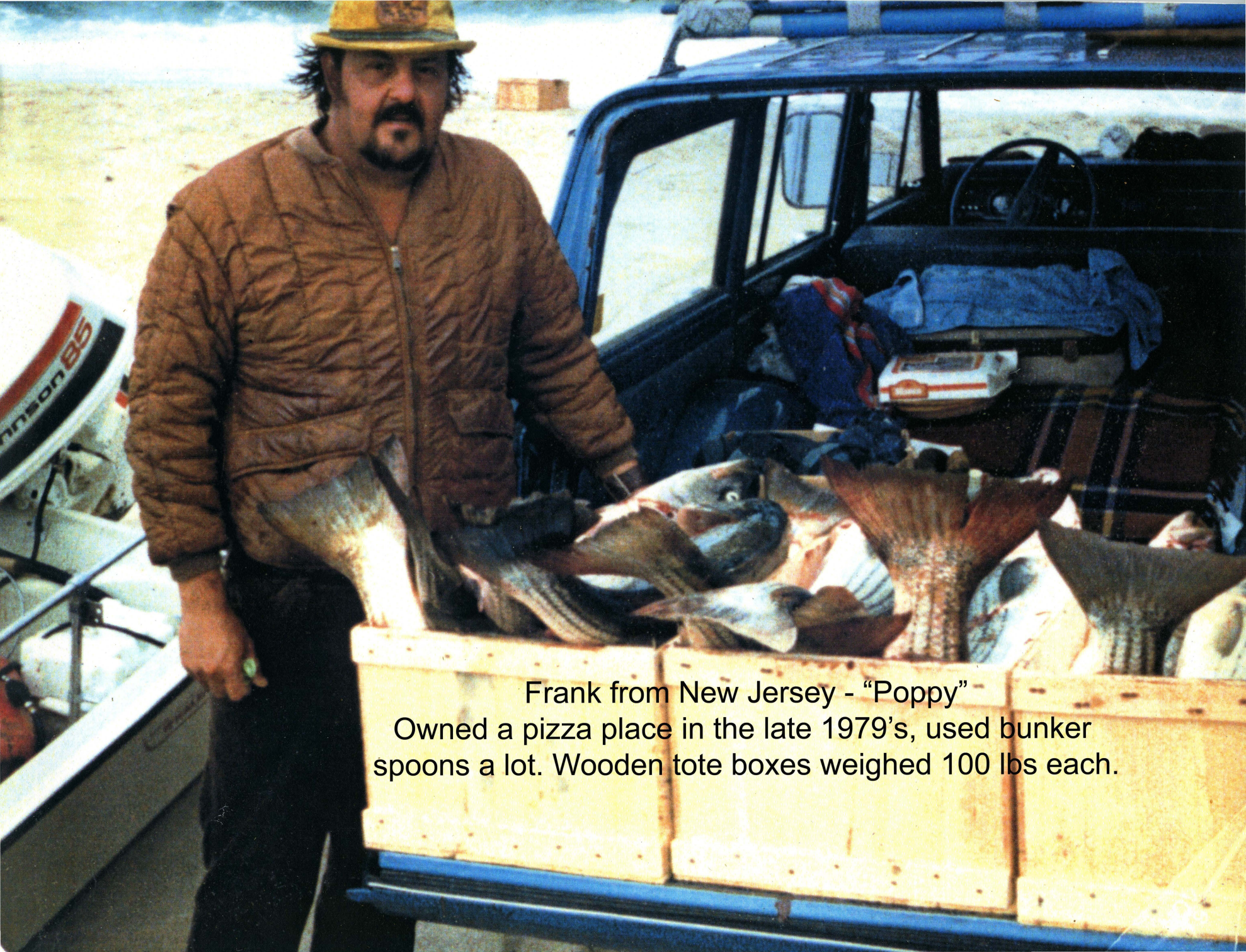
