**THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-seven

**AN ACT** AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PROVINCETOWN TO APPROPRIATE MONEY IN CONNECTION WITH THE CELEBRATION AND RECEPTION OF THE MAYFLOWER II.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: SECTION 1. The town of Provincetown is hereby

authorized to appropriate a sum of money not to exceed three thousand dollars, to be expended for entertainment and other events in connection with the proposed celebration and reception of the Mayflower II in the years nineteen hundred and fifty-seven and nineteen hundred and fifty-eight. The money so appropriated shall be disbursed under the direction of the town manager.

SECTION 2. Any action taken by a town meeting in the current year pursuant to authority contained in section one of this act shall be valid and effective as though this act were in effect at the time of the posting of the warrant for said meeting. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
