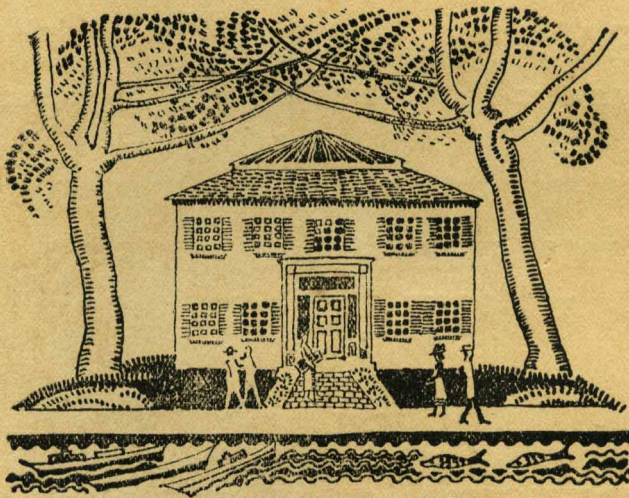

**Article II.
