Foreword.

Castle Mayflower of the order of Knights of King Arthur was organized in August, Nineteen Hundred Eight with a membership of eight boys. The club now has a membership of nineteen active and one associate member.

In the Fall we hope to introduce instruction in various trades and arts, thus fitting the boys for lives of larger usefulness and service.
