**Article II. 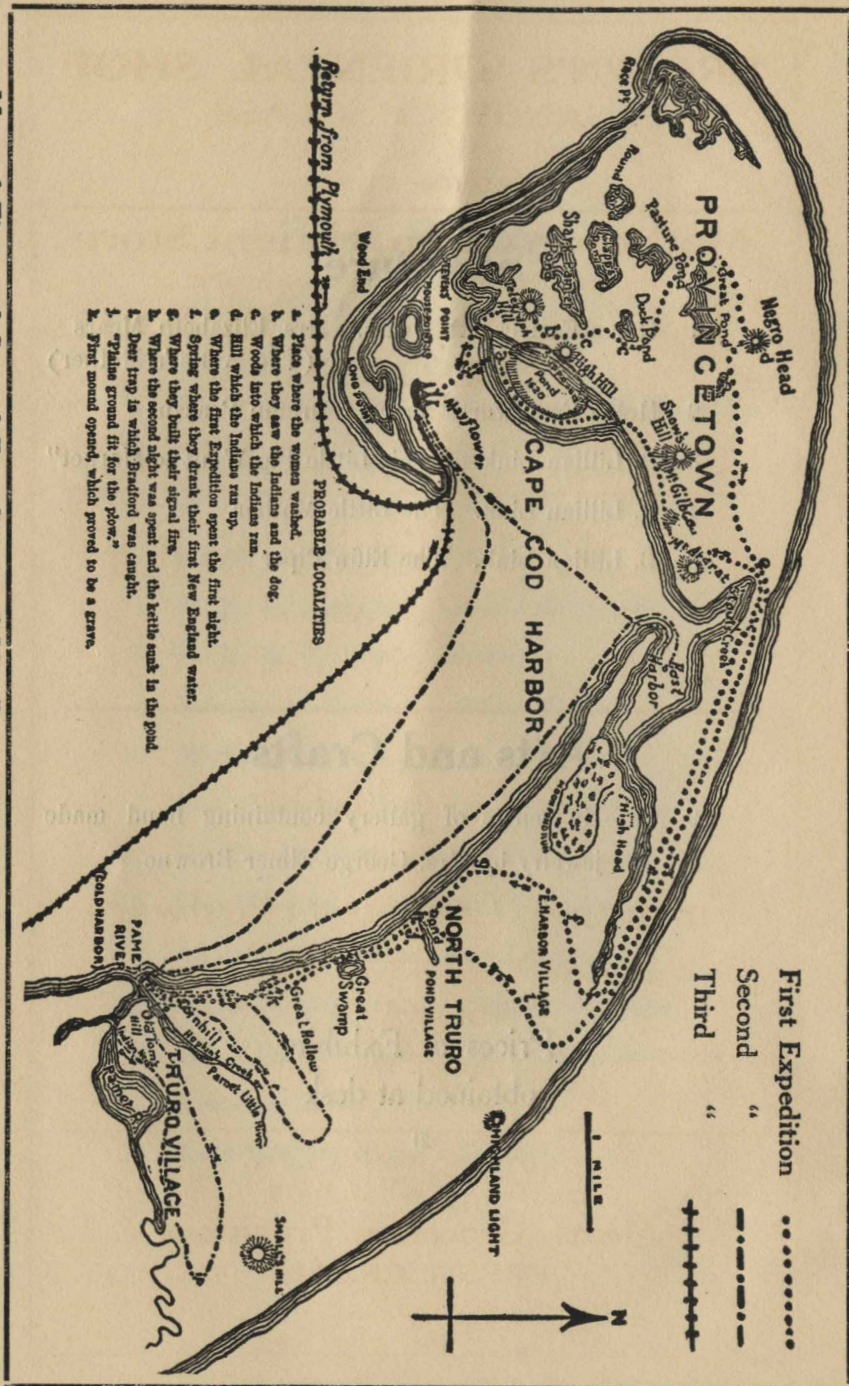

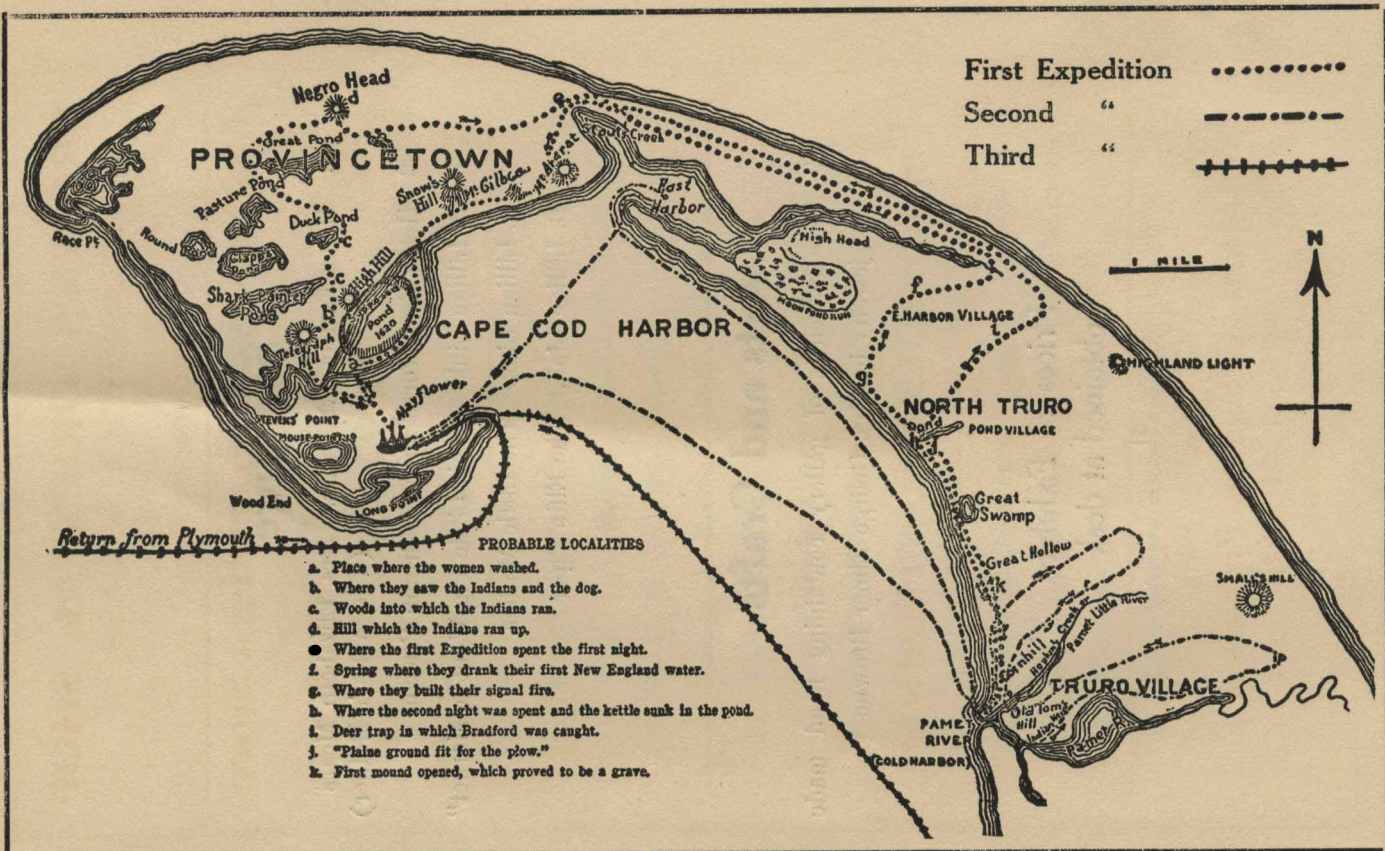
