

#### **ABOUT THE READINGS**

**Aria Da Capo**, a one-act play by Edna St.Vincent Millary, was written in 1919 following World War I and originally performed by the Provincetown Players in 1920. *Aria Da Capo* is clearly a response to the Great War, World War I. In *Aria Da Capo* Millay resurrects the harlequinade or commedia de l'arte style as a means to address contemporary struggles. The piece begins with Columbine and Pierrot as a comfortable bourgeois couple; their energies restricted to idle chatter, pallid love, and self-indulgence. Their light comedy is interrupted by the grim appearance of Cothurnus who demands that the stage be turned over to a tragedy. The play exposes the dangers of power and the lasting tragedy of World War I in an ingenious manner. Not only was Millay a founding member of the Provincetown Players as both a writer and actress, she was also honored in 1923 as the first woman to be awarded the Pulitzer Prize for poetry.
