SENIOR CLASS – 1980

Class History

In the fall of 1976, we, the Class of 1980, enrolled as Freshmen in Provincetown High School. Our first job was to elect class officers and Student Council representatives. Elected to the Student Council were Joanne Gibson and Keith Brazil. To guide us through our first year, we elected Mr. Fred Turner as our class advisor.

On October 12, 1976, we were welcomed by the Seniors at our Freshman Reception. We marched to the theme of "Disco Duck" wearing duck bills and bibs.
