VFW Members Start Digging at Provincetown



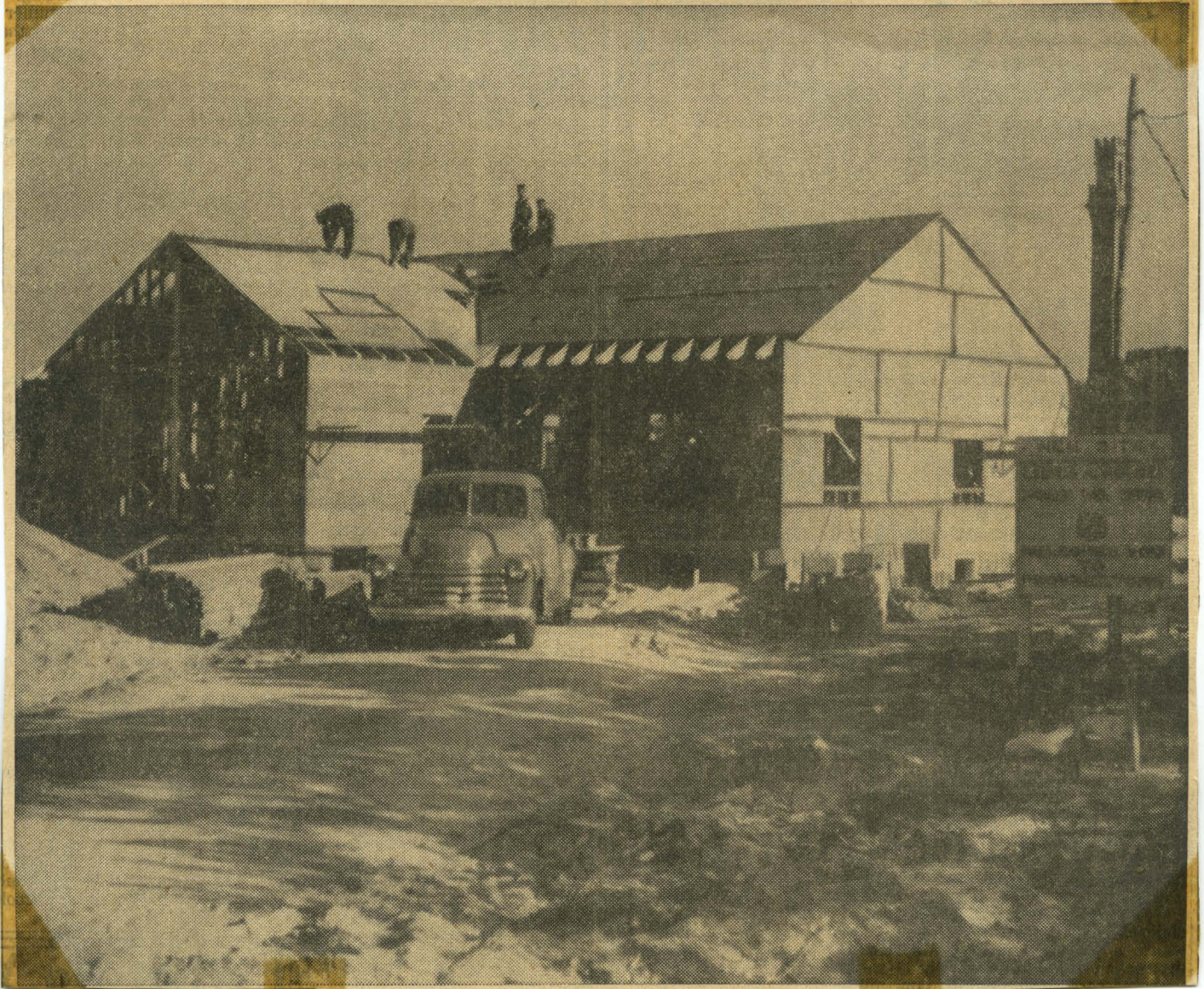
