Dear Sir:

The National Weir Co. has been regularly dissolved by decree of Court and certificate of dissolution filed with the Secretary of State. This makes an end of the corporation, but the usual franchise tax will be required for this year as the dissolution came after June 1st.

I enclose, herewith, bill for services and expenses. The corporation is allowed by Statute three years, if it requires so much time, to settle up the old corporation accounts. I understand, however, there is nothing remaining to be done except to exchange the old shares for shares in the Provincetown Trap Co. I enclose a form of notice to be sent to the stockholders.
