## SIXTY-FIVE YEARS AGO Steamer Cape Cod

The carpenters will practically finsh their work on the Cape Ced this week, although a few will be at work next week putting on the finishing touches.

The machinist is behind on his contract, and says the engines will be in running order by the 10th of July; but the directors do not believe that the Cape Cod will be able to begin regular trips before the 15th of July.

The landing place in Boston will be at Otis wharf, 410 Atlantic Ave. A large sign is at the head of the wharf and reads as follows: "Bay Line Steamer Cape Cod for Provincetown."
