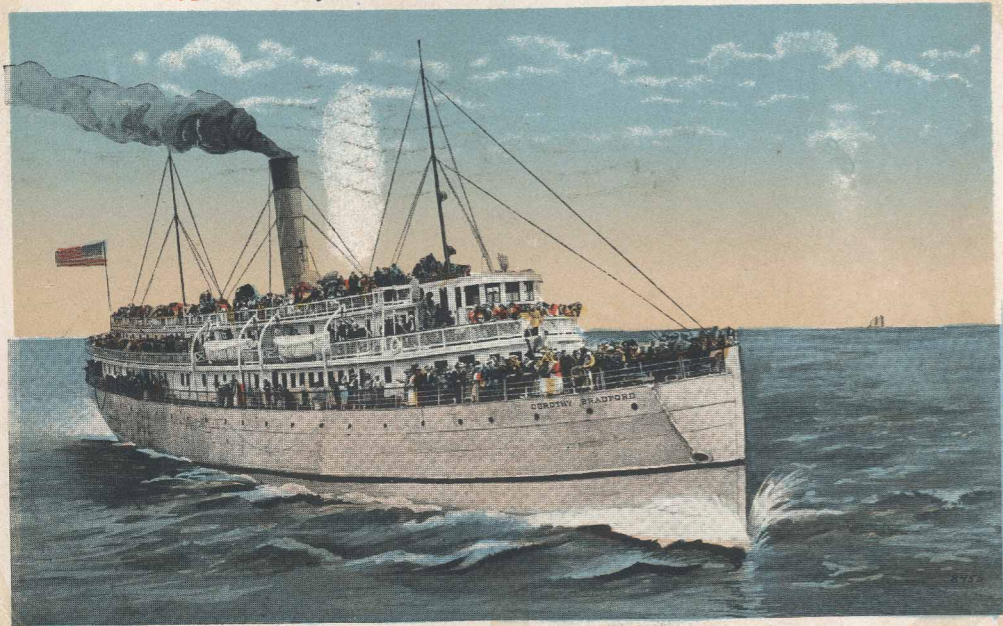
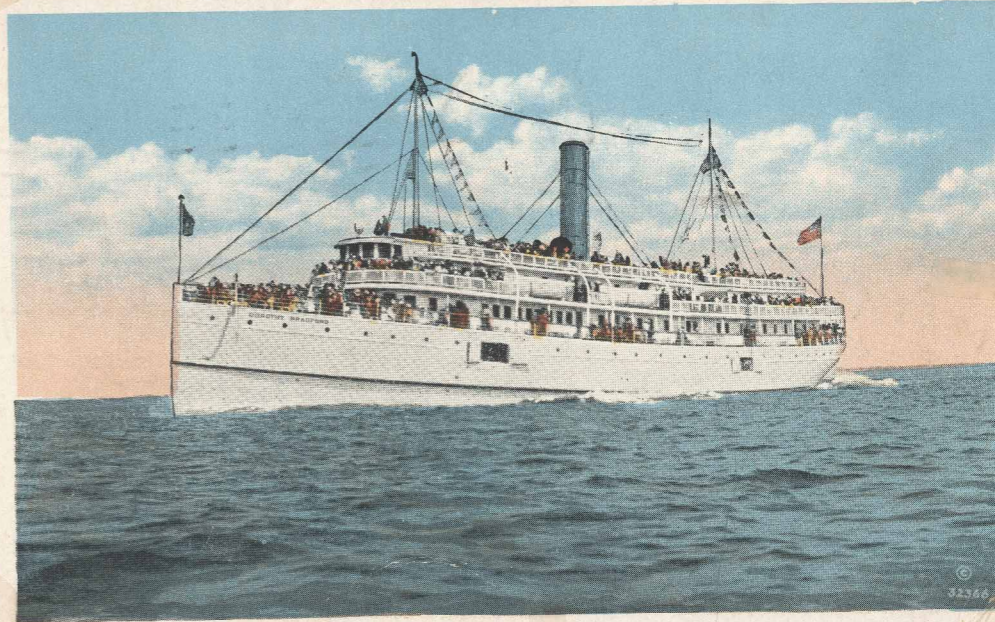


902 Str. Dorothy Bradford arriving at Provincetown, Mass.



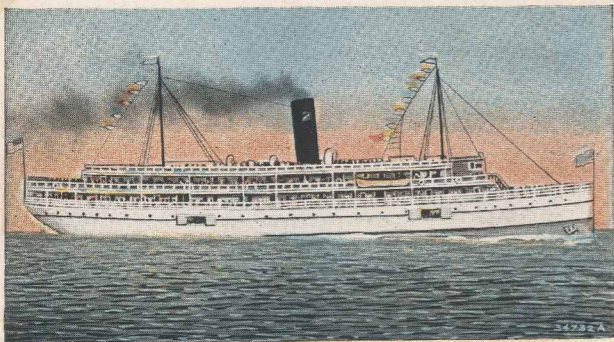
