WHARF WORK 1900:

Captain John Atkins has hauled his large sailboat into carpenter Bickers work yard for a general overhauling . . . Captain Whitcomb and his gang of workmen are at work on Knowles Wharf putting in new deck stringers, etc. A large portion of the wharf has been repaired but the decking at the lower end for a distance of nearly 100 feet will all be removed and the wharf made as good as new. The whole time used in repairs to the wharf will probably exceed four or five weeks.
