88 Commercial St. is a 2-story, 3/4 cottage with side ell; dwelling has been converted to multi-family use; cross-gable roof sheathed in asphalt shingles with partial cornice returns; gable dormer on front roof slope; exterior clad in wood shingles with corner boards; fenestration includes replacement windows with trim wrapped in aluminum, 2/2 aluminum DHS in gable dormer, left (Commercial St.) has 6/6 DHS replacements; rear (Cottage Street) has U-shaped-single and paired 6/6 and 8/8 DHS replacements; multiple entrances with replacement doors; exterior wood staircase to 2nd-floor entrance on gable-front façade.
