505.06 feet distant from Station 137+67.85 of the Main Base Line of said

Layout No. 4070, thence leaving said location line and running

The above-described land is hereby conveyed subject to the following agreements, conditions and restrictions:

- 1. By the acceptance of this deed, the Town of Provincetown agrees to erect a chain link fence on the southeast bound of the above-described parcel of land, the same being the State Highway/Town Boundary Line; and said Town further agrees that it will not convey any part or all of the above-described land to any person or agency, except to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 2. This conveyance is subject to the condition that no drainage from said Route #6, in, under or upon the above-described land, will be obstructed by any use to which said land may be put by the Town of Provincetown.

3. This conveyance is subject to the restrictions that no vehicle access to the above-described land will be permitted except between Stations 155± and 157± of the Main Base Line of said Layout No. 4070; that no pedestrian gate will be permitted except at Station 143± of said Main Base Line; and that no rubbish disposal will be permitted on the above-described land.

The above-described land is no longer needed for State highway purposes.

This deed is intended to take effect as a sealed instrument.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, acting on behalf of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, did, under date of September 8, 1953 (Layout No. 4070) lay out and take charge of as a State highway a road in the Town of Provincetown, County of Barnstable, being known as Relocation of Route 6, as shown on the plans of said State highway on file in the office of the Department of Public Works, copies of which plans have been filed in the office of the County Commissioners of said County of Barnstable, at Barnstable, and in the office of the Town Clerk of said Town of Provincetown; and

WHEREAS, it now appears advisable to make certain changes in the location lines of said State highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, acting under the provisions of Chapter 81 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition thereof, and acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto, the Department of Public Works adjudges that public necessity and convenience require that the Commonwealth should alter the location of said State highway, and should lay out and take charge of said State highway as altered, as hereinafter described.

The alteration consists of revising a portion of the northwesterly location line of said State highway to correspond

certain of with/the boundaries of land no longer needed for State highway purposes which was conveyed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. acting through its Department of Public Works, to the Town of Provincetown by a deed dated July 20, 1966,

The baseline of location for this alteration is a portion of the main baseline of location of the aforesaid September 8, 1953 State highway layout and the stations hereinafter referred to are points thereon.

The northwesterly location line of the State highway as hereby altered and laid out begins at a point on the northwesterly location line of the aforesaid 1953 State highway layout, said point bearing north 540-37'-05" west and being 505.06 feet distant from station 137+67.85 and extends thence, leaving said location line south 540-37'-05" east 349.39 feet to a point bearing north 54°-37'-05" west and 155.67 feet distant from said station 137+67.85; thence south 500-53'-26" west 2399.22 feet to a point bearing north 39°-06'-34" west and 150.00 feet distant from station 162+08.69; thence by a curve to the right of 5850.00 feet radius 771.53 feet to a point bearing north 310-33'-11" west and 150.00 feet distant from station 170; thence north 310-33'-11" west 440.00 feet to a point bearing north 310-33'-11" west and 590.00 feet distant from said station 170; thence north 270-27'-16" east 1221.96 feet to the point of ending thereof, again on the northwesterly location line of the aforesaid September 8, 1953 State highway layout, said point bearing north 190-03'-54" west and being 1195.39 feet distant from station 162+08.69.

The location line of the State highway altered and laid out as hereinbefore described is to be further defined by bounds set thereon at angle points, points of curvature, and at the points of beginning and ending thereof.

The State highway hereby altered and laid out is shown on a plan signed by Daniel S. Horgan, Chief Engineer, and signed by the Department of Public Works and on file in its office, said plan being entitled: "The Commonwealth of Massachusetts Plan of Road in the Town of Provincetown Barnstable County Altered and Laid out as a State Highway by the Department of Public Works 1966. Scale: 240 feet to the inch", an attested copy of which is to be recorded with this order of layout in the Registry of Deeds for Barnstable County, at Barnstable.

It is therefore

Voted: That said way as altered, as described herein, and as described and shown on said plan, be and the same is hereby laid out and taken charge of by the Commonwealth; that the Secretary to the Public Works Commission, be and hereby is instructed to file in the office of the County Commissioners of the County and in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town in which said way is located. certified copies of said plan and of a certificate, signed by at least a majority of the members of the Department of Public Works, attesting that said Department of Public Works has laid out and taken charge of said way as altered in accordance with said plan, together with a copy of this adjudication and vote.
