Dear George:-

I'm afraid I can't contribute very much. I don't remember any of the other acts in the show, and I don't rembember ever seeing the program. I was not a soloist. "You're the Cream in My Coffee" was a duet with Catharine Santos. We'd sung it in "The Man Who Owns Broadway", a show put on by the Catholic Church the winter before.

Like you, I am amazed at the outpouring of generosity by all elements of the town. You're right about it not happening today. I think the explanation is that we must keep in mind that it was long before the Welfare State. There were no government entitlements then. We had the Poor House, the churches, and a few fraternal organizations. And, above all, our neighbors. We helped each other because we never knew when we would need help ourselves.

There must have been some one person who put it all together. I don't know who it was. I can't even remember who asked me to be in it.

I'm sorry I can't be of more help. Thanks for the program, and Izabel thanks you for The Long Pointer piece. Best wishes for the holidays.
