Thank you for the time we've had together. I wish you all of the best as you go forward into your futures.

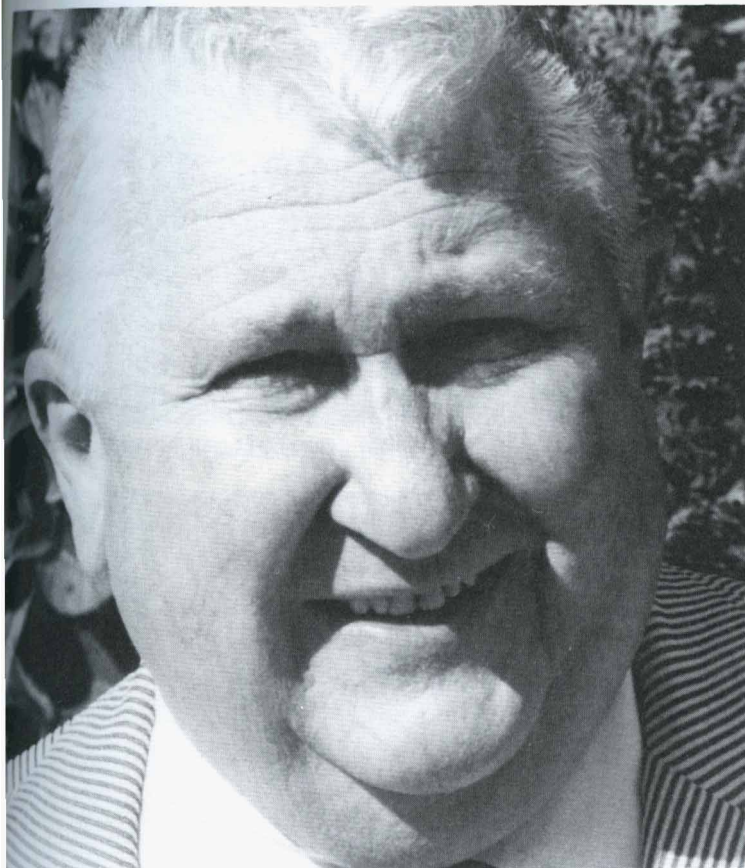
