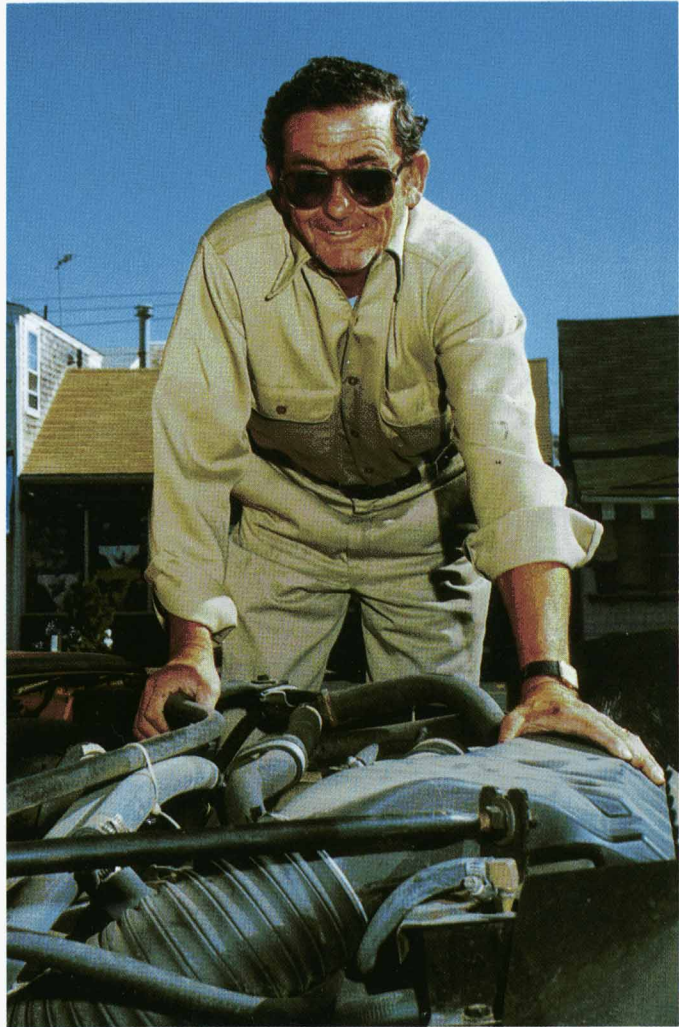
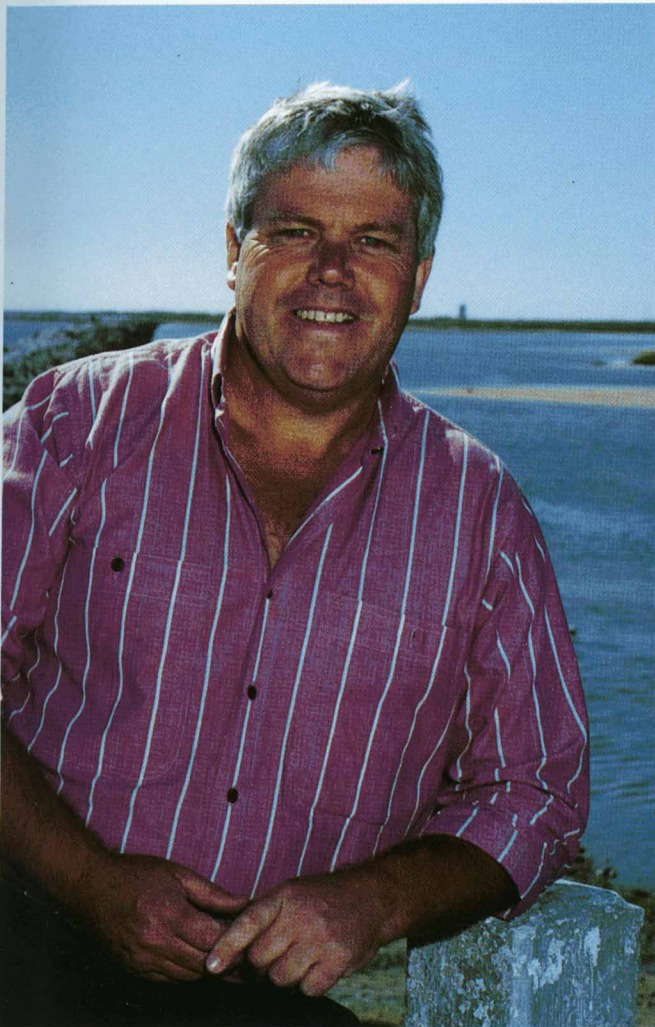


TRIBUTES
